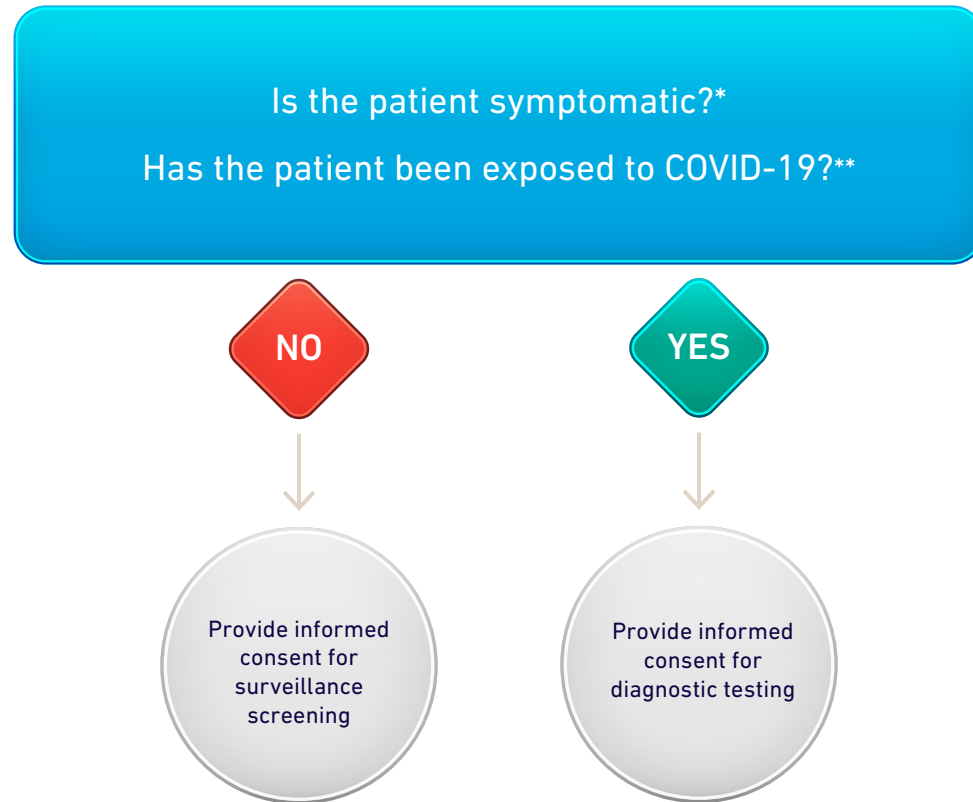


SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) Decision Support Tool

- **Accepted Sample Types:** Nasal Swab, Nasopharyngeal Swab
- **Possible Results:** Positive, Negative, Indeterminate
- Testing may be ordered by the provider (TC 1299) or the patient (TC 1297)

SYMPTOMS*

Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure. Some carriers may not display symptoms.

Moderate Symptoms	Cough, sore throat
	Fever or chills
	Muscle or body aches
	Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea
	New loss of taste or smell
	Congestion or runny nose
	Fatigue
Severe Symptoms	Headache
	Shortness of breath, difficulty breathing
	Persistent pain or pressure in chest
	New confusion
	Inability to wake or stay awake
	Bluish lips or face

If the patient has severe symptoms, the patient should seek medical attention immediately.

EXPOSURE**

If the patient has been around a family member or someone else with a confirmed COVID-19 case.

If the patient has been around a family member or someone else with suspected COVID-19 based on exposures.

If the patient has been around a family member or someone else with suspected COVID-19 based on symptoms.
