Prenatal WES Trio is used when prenatal imaging detects an anomaly that strongly suggests there is an underlying genetic etiology.

INDICATIONS FOR TESTING

- Prenatal ultrasound with abnormal findings
- Positive prenatal screening tests
- Uninformative prior prenatal diagnostic testing

FETAL REPORT INCLUDES:

- Pathogenic or likely pathogenic variants in disease genes related to the prenatal indications
- Variants in disease genes unrelated to the prenatal indications, but likely to cause severe childhood-onset disorders
